## Maximum Permissible Gross Mass Load §178.703(a)(1)(viii)

Value listed in kilograms - no units (total weight allowed to be filled in IBC plus container weight (tare weight)

### Rated Capacity §178.703(b)(1)(i)

Value listed in liters of water list units "L" 275 gal IBC typically 1040 or 1041 L 330 gal IBC typically 1250 or 1251 L

#### Gauge Test Pressure §178.703(b)(1)(iii)

(weight of empty container)

Value listed in kilopascals - list units "kPa" (demonstrated during design type qualification test)

Tare Mass (weight) §178.703(b)(1)(ii) Value listed in kilograms - list units "kg"

#### Date of last leak test §178.703(b)(1)(iv)

2 digits month, 2 digits year (no hyphens or slashes in between numbers)

#### Date of last inspection §178.703(b)(1)(v)

2 digits month, 2 digits year (no hyphens or slashes in between numbers)

#### IBC Code Letter (Material) Designations §178.702(a)(s)

A = Steel

C = Wood

F = Reconstituted Wood

H = Plastic

M = Multiwall Paper

B = Aluminum

D = Plywood

G = Fiberboard

L = Textile

N = Metal (other than A or B)

Letters and numbers must be at least 12 mm (0.47 in)
